Introduction to Beekeeping

The course is also suitable for those who have already started, but have little experience. It is based on the knowledge gained from 60 years beekeeping experience, not just repeating what is in books, as many courses do.

<u>Tutors: Daisy Day</u>, a long-time beekeeper who is a Master Beekeeper and <u>Roger Patterson</u>, who started beekeeping in 1963 and has been teaching the craft for over 50 years. He is a prolific speaker, demonstrator and writer, where his down to earth approach is appreciated.
