I imagine most of you have treated or are planning to treat your bees for *Varroa* when they are near or completely broodless. Wouldn't it be great if we didn't have to treat for *Varroa* and our bees could live with light infestations. Well as you know WSBKA are helping to fund the

ReVive\* project and this is aimed at identifying European honeybee populations that can persist without *Varroa* control. We look forward to a general report next year when all the data has been analysed and to see how the project has helped in understanding *Varroa* and the DWV variants.



I hope to see some of you on Friday at the National Honey Show  $26^{th}$ — $28^{th}$  October at Sandown Park Racecourse and don't forget that on Saturday  $28^{th}$  some of the lectures are aimed at beginners and will be hosted by WSBKA's Roger and Daisy.
